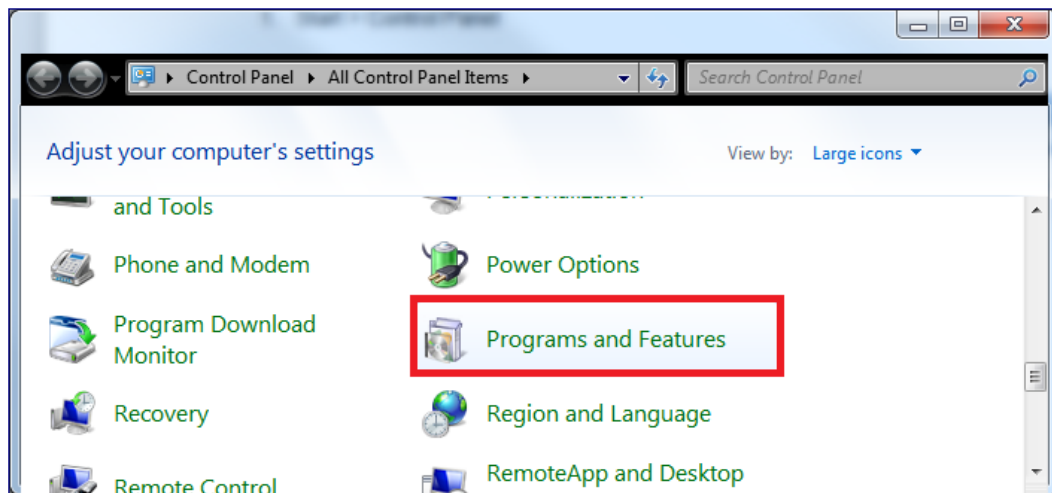
Guide for Windows users to downgrade Firefox



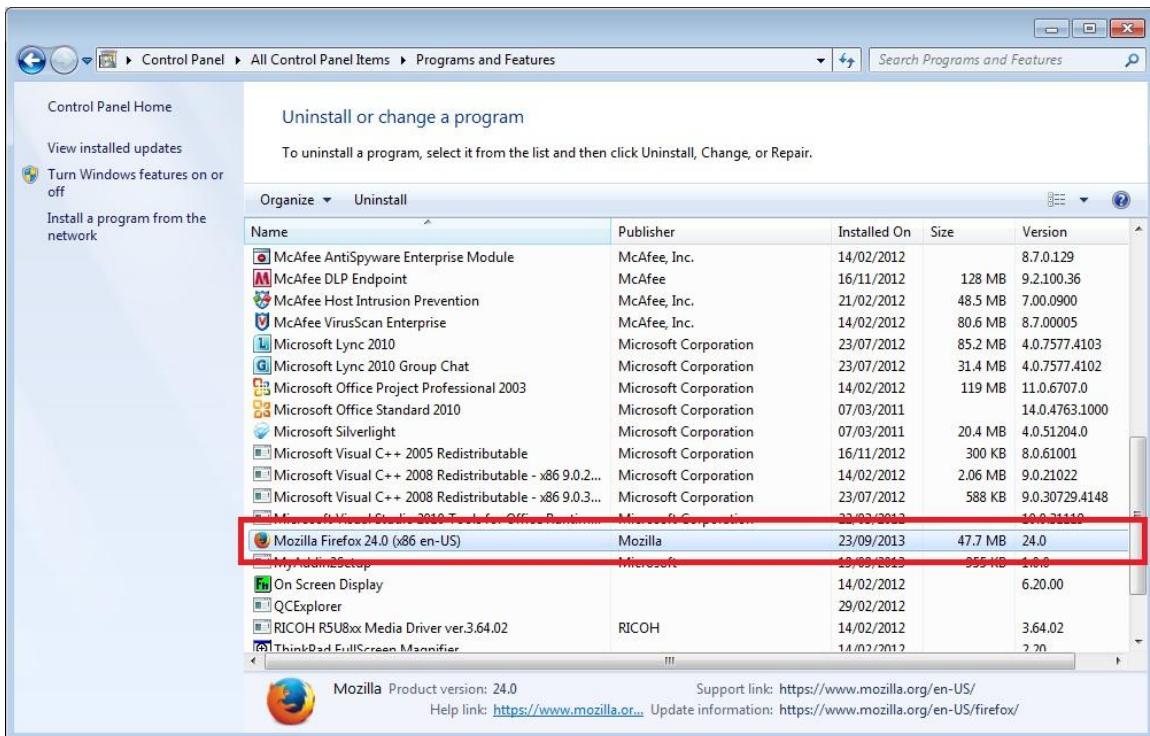
Downgrade Firefox in Windows

Note: Before starting the installation, please ensure that all Firefox windows are closed.

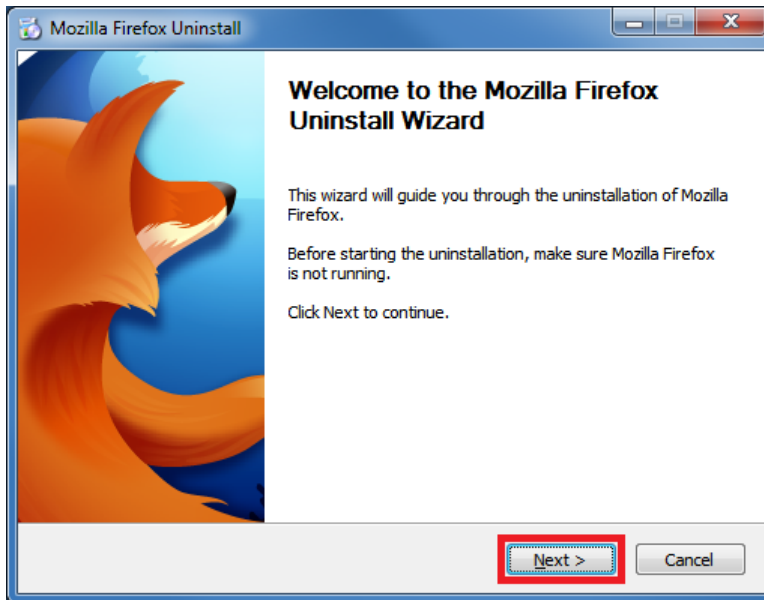
1. Start > Control Panel
2. Double click on **Programs and Features**



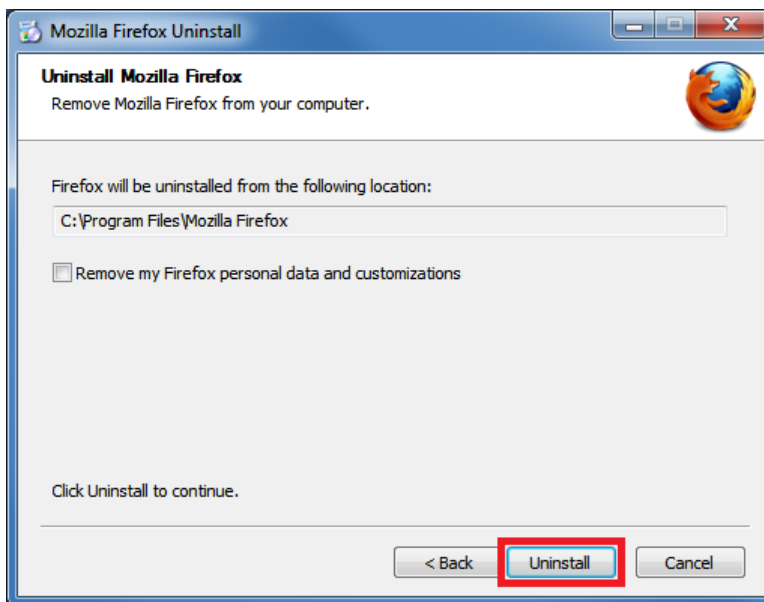
3. Double click on **Mozilla Firefox 24.0 (same steps for versions 21/22/23)**



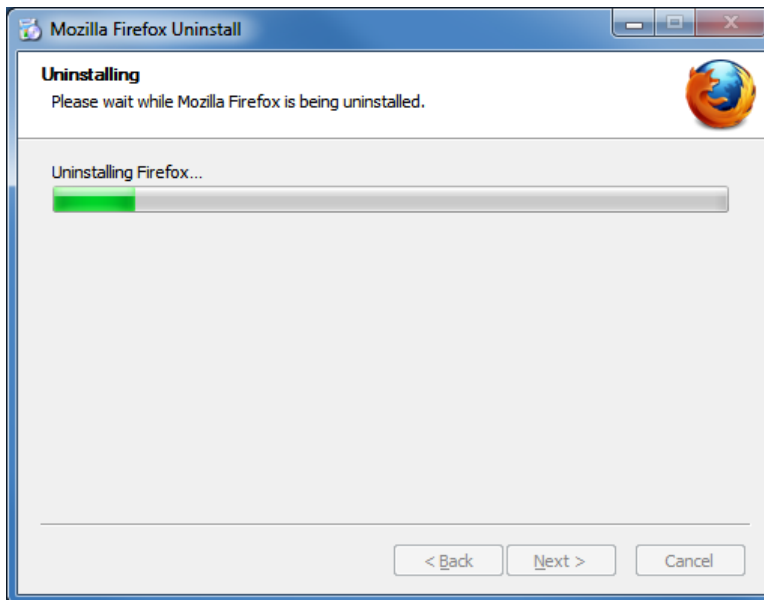
4. Click on **Next >**



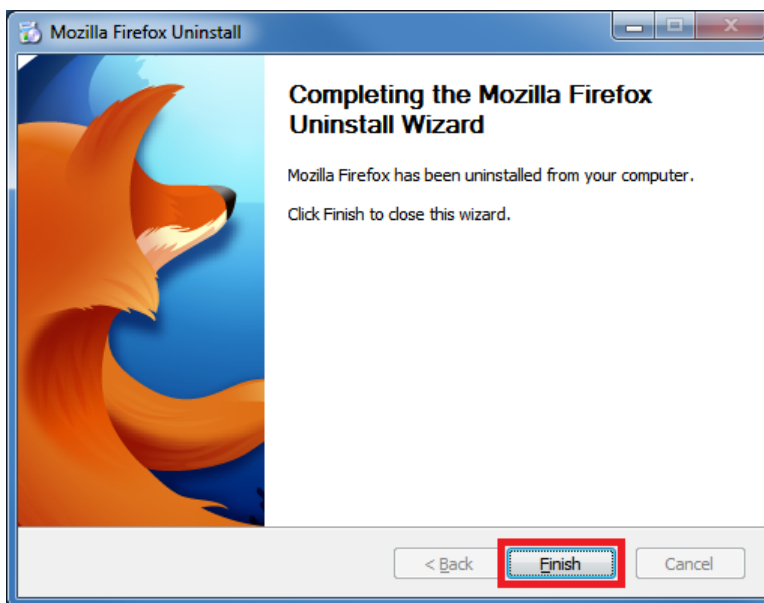
5. Click on **Uninstall**



6. Wait for the uninstallation to complete



7. Click **Finish**



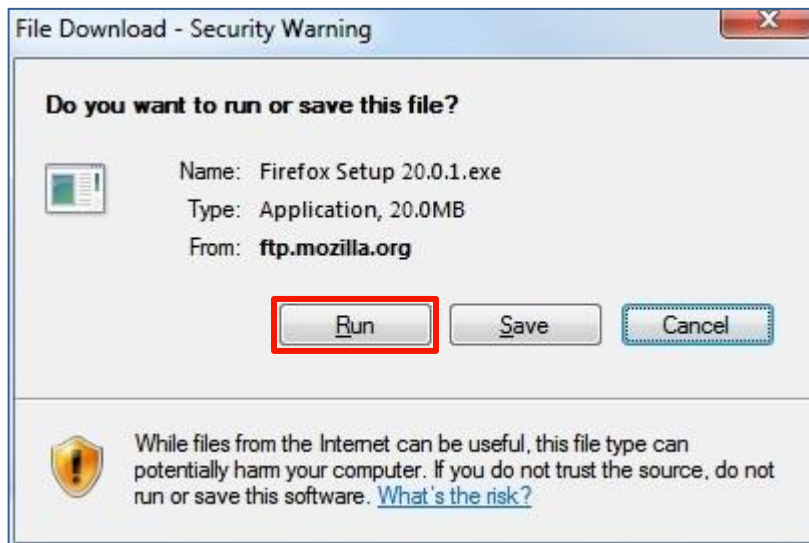
8. Launch the following URL using Internet Explorer or other browsers:

<http://ftp.mozilla.org/pub/mozilla.org/firefox/releases/20.0.1/win32/en-US/>

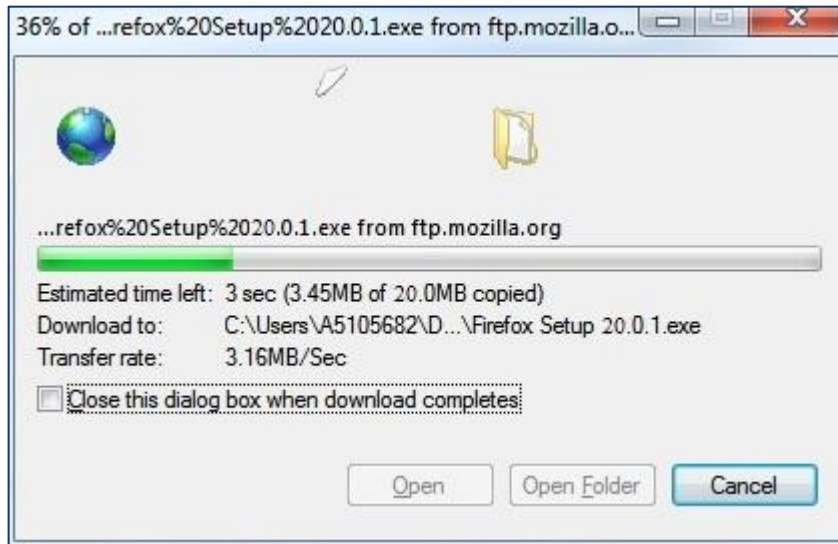
9. Click on “**Firefox Setup 20.0.1.exe**”



10. Click on **Run**



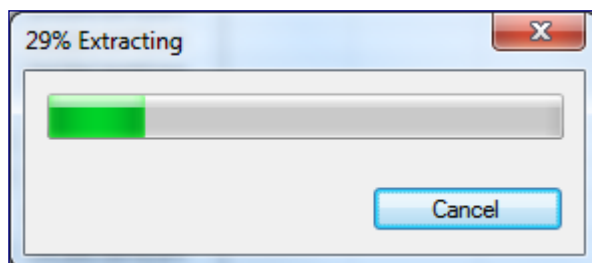
11. Wait for the download to complete



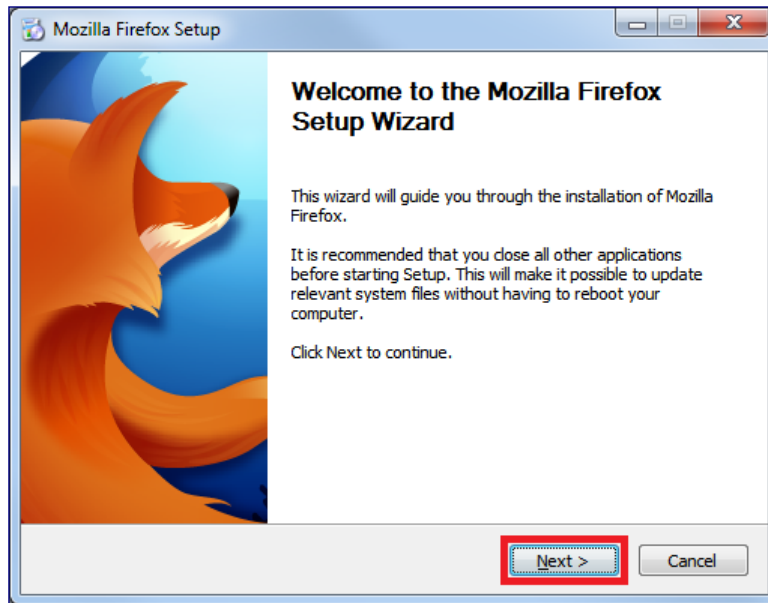
12. Click on **Run**



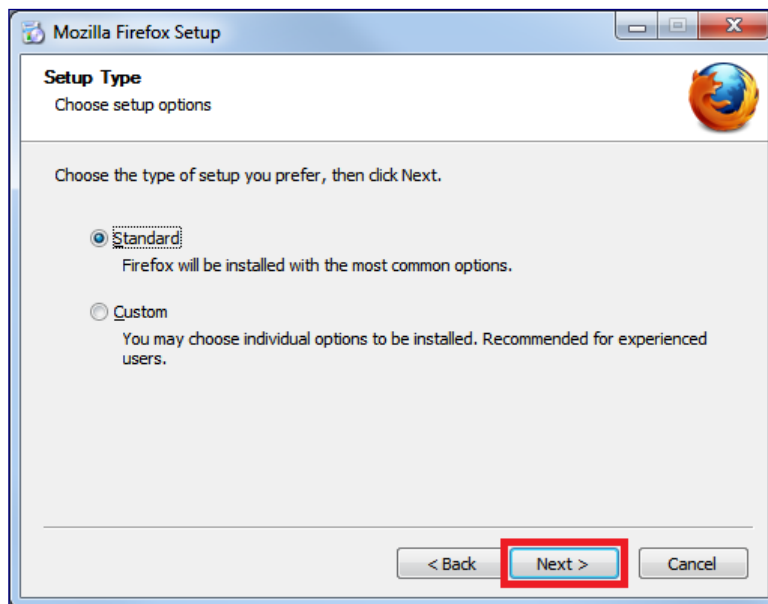
13. Wait for the extraction to be completed



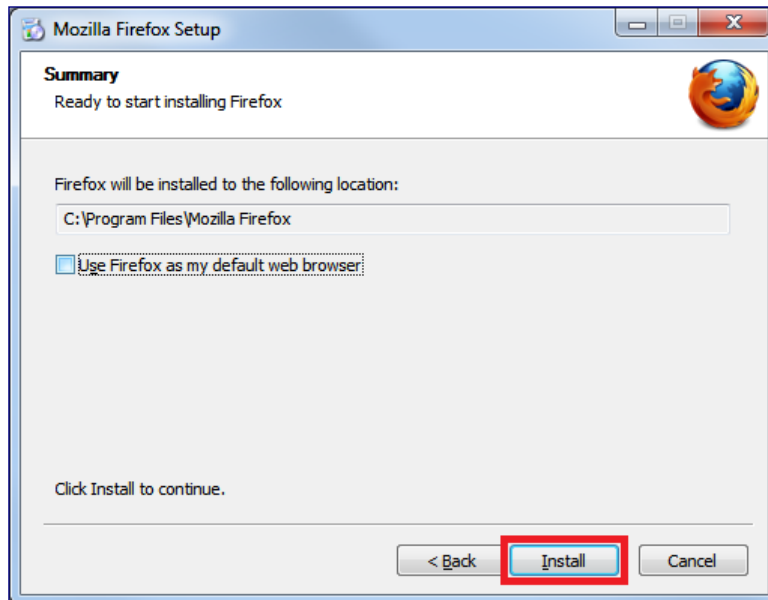
14. Click on **Next >**



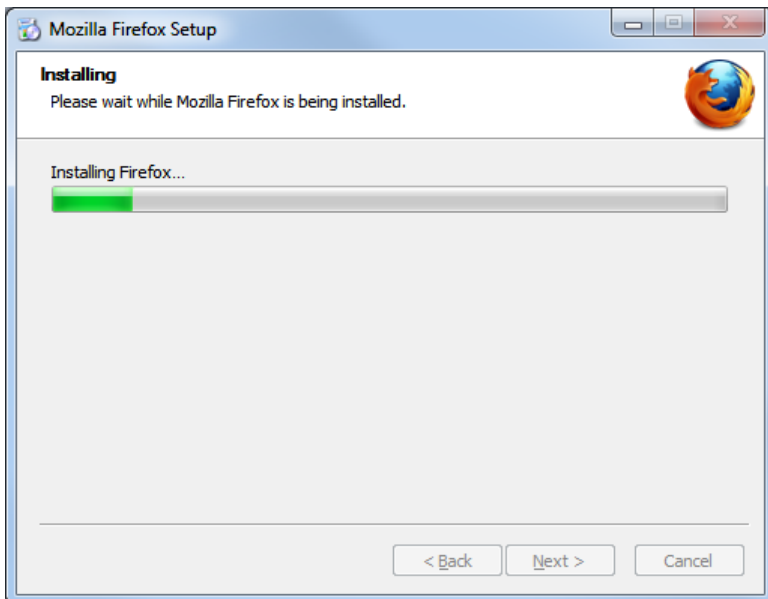
15. Select Standard and Click on Next >



16. Click on **Install**



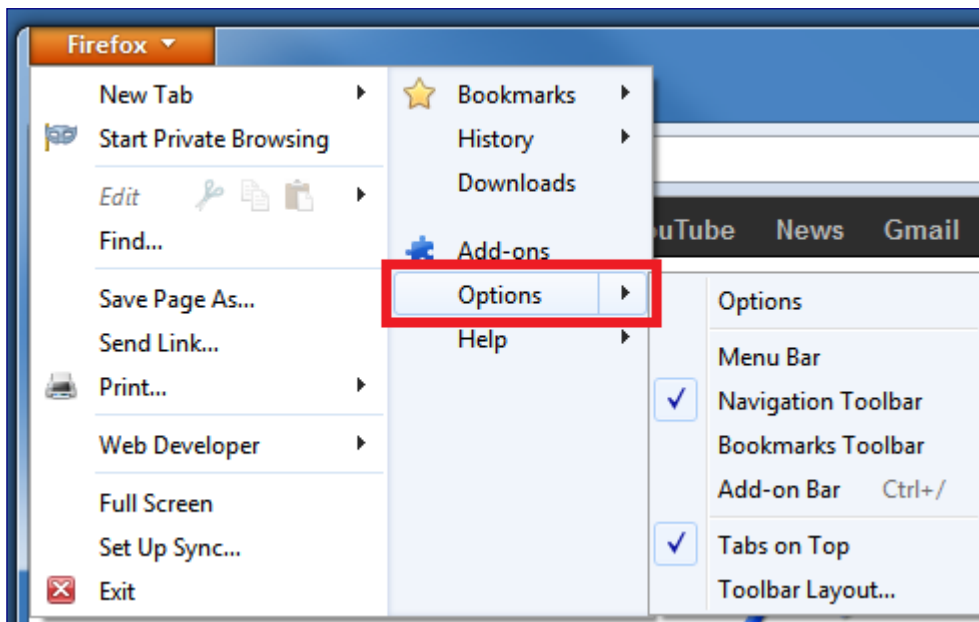
17. Wait for the installation to be completed



18. Click on **Finish**



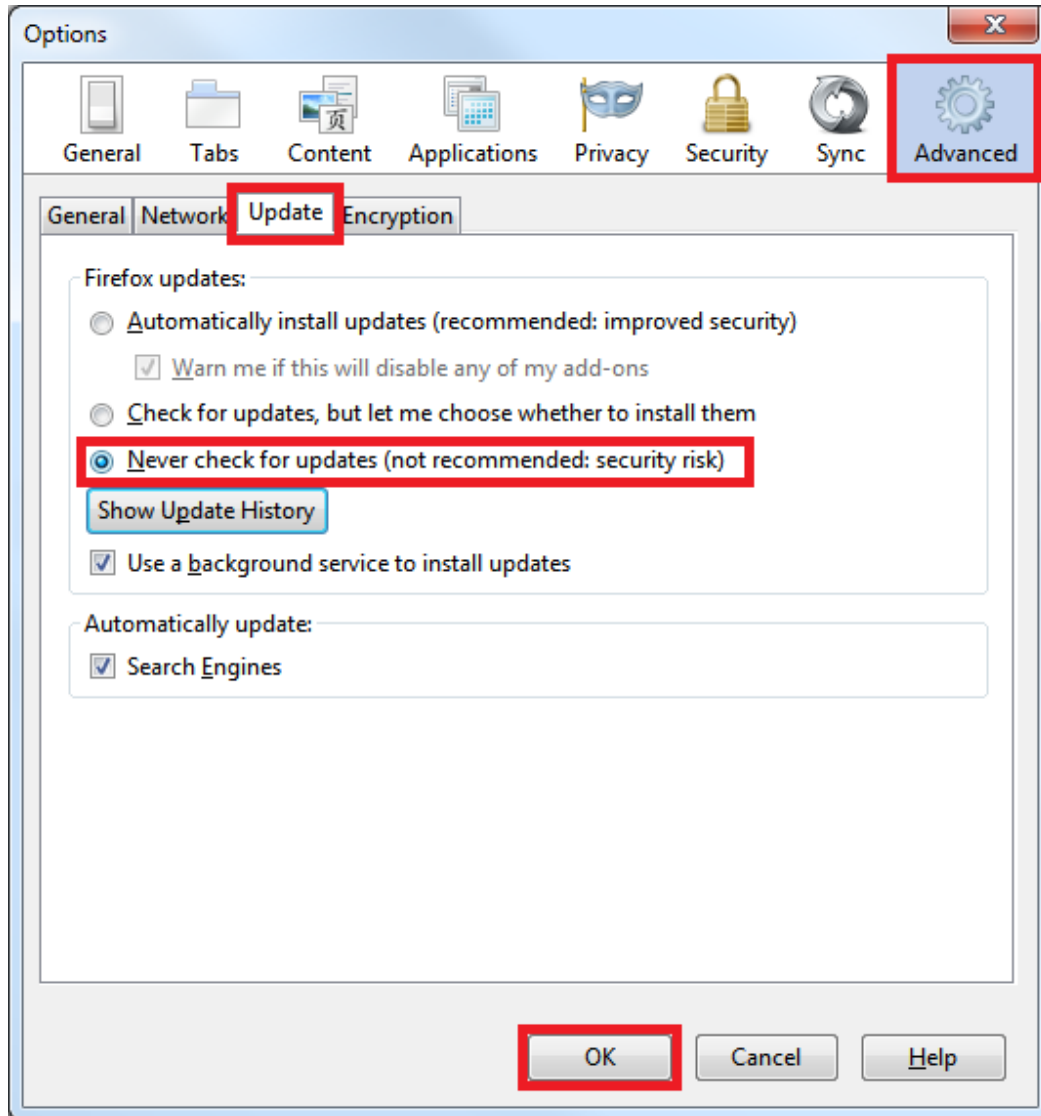
19. Once Firefox 15 is launched, click on **Firefox** (on the top left) > **Options**



20. Go to **Advanced > Update**

21. Select “**Never check for updates**” then click on **OK**

Note: Do not be alarmed by the “not recommended: security risk” option, you can always update your Firefox browser as and when you want via the Firefox website.



22. Downgrade is completed.
