

Terms and Conditions Governing the MaxMaternity Care and OCBC Child Development Account Promotion (the "Promotion")

1. Promotion Period: From 1 January 2018 to 31 December 2018 or for such other periods as may be determined by OCBC Bank in its discretion.
2. Subject to paragraph 3 below, the Promotion is open to individuals who sign-up for MaxMaternity Care ("an Eligible Customer") during the Promotion Period and subsequently open an OCBC Child Development Account by 30 June 2019. Each Eligible Customer will be entitled to receive a cash reward of S\$108 (the "Gift") pursuant to the terms and conditions of this Promotion.
3. Each Eligible Customer is only entitled to receive one Gift under the terms of this Promotion, regardless of the number of MaxMaternity Care plans signed-up during the Promotion Period. The eligibility of any customer to receive the Gift shall be determined at the absolute discretion of OCBC Bank.
4. The S\$108 cash reward will be credited into the OCBC Child Development Account, opened jointly by the Eligible Customer and the child, 4 weeks after the opening of the OCBC Child Development Account.
5. The S\$108 insurance premium voucher can only be used to fully or partially offset the first year premium of your child's Supreme Health plan when he/she is born. Supreme Health is a Medisave-approved Integrated Shield Plan by The Great Eastern Life Assurance Company Limited.
6. OCBC Bank reserves the right to waive, vary or amend any of the terms and conditions of this Promotion without notice. The decision of OCBC Bank on all matters relating to this Promotion shall be final and binding.
7. In the event of any inconsistency between these terms and conditions and the contents of any brochure, marketing or promotional material relating to this Promotion, these terms and conditions shall prevail.
8. A person who is not a party to any agreement governed by these terms and conditions shall have no right under the Contracts (Right of Third Parties) Act (Cap 53B) to enforce any of these terms and conditions.
9. These terms and conditions shall be governed by laws of Singapore and the participants irrevocably submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Singapore.
