Terms & Conditions Governing the OCBC Pay Anyone Contest

- 1. The OCBC Pay Anyone Contest (the "Contest") is open only to individual customers who maintain personal current and/or savings accounts with Oversea-Chinese Banking Corporation Limited ("OCBC Bank") in Singapore, and have access to OCBC Bank Internet/Mobile Banking ("OCBC Bank Online Banking"). For the avoidance of doubt, corporate and business accounts customers are not eligible to participate in this Contest.
- 2. To participate in the Contest, a customer has to:
 - a) successfully log in to their personal current and/or savings account(s);

The decision of OCBC Bank on all matters relating to the Contest and these terms and conditions shall be final, binding and conclusive on all participants, including without limitation, any decision on the eligibility of any person or cancellation or suspension of the Contest. Subject to and without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, OCBC Bank's record of the entries, allocated chances and/or any decision made in connection with the Contest shall be final, binding and conclusive for all purposes. No correspondence or appeal will be entertained.
- 10. In the event of any inconsistency between these terms and conditions and any brochure, marketing or promotional materials relating to the Contest, these terms and conditions shall prevail.
