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
Greater China – Wuhan Coronavirus Monitor

10 February 2020



Summary (as of 9 Feb 2020)

- # Statistics: Total oustanding number of suspected cases have declined significantly to 23589 from 28942 although total confirmed cases passed 40K.
- # Situation in Hubei Province: Fatality rate in Wuhan fell to 4%. Hubei is using grassroots to identify as many patients as possible. However, % of patients in critical illness remained high above 20%.
- # Situation outside Hubei province: Fatality rate outside Hubei Province increased to 0.4% after staying at around 0.2% for about 10 days. The good news is that 14.1% patients outside Hubei province have recovered. Daily increase of new confirmed declined.
- # Our thoughts: I have good feeling that the outbreak in Hubei Province may have entered the last leg after more patients have been identified. Technically, all the suspect patients should have been tested as of 9 Feb in Wuhan based on the deadline set by government. Outside Hubei province, 444 new cases were confirmed on 9 Feb, lowest since 26 January. This signals that there is no signs of second wave contagion yet. However, given millions of migrant workers will return in the next one week, we will continue to monitor the situation outside Hubei closely. The recovery rate is encouraging. 14.1% of patients outside Hubei province has been discharged. Unfortunately, the % of patients in critical illness and fatality rate outside Hubei province rebounded respectively to 10.9% and 0.4% respectively.



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
