

Terms and Conditions Governing the OCBC 365 Credit Card New Sign-up Promotion 2019 (the "Promotion")

Promotion Period

1. The Promotion Period shall be from 1 April 2019 to 31 July 2019 (both dates inclusive), or such other period as may be determined by Oversea-Chinese Banking Corporation Limited ("OCBC") in its absolute discretion ("Promotion Period").

Eligibility

2. The Promotion is open to applicants who meet all the following conditions (collectively "Eligible Cardmembers" and each an "Eligible Cardmember"):-
 - a) the relevant individual must have successfully applied for a OCBC 365 Credit Card ("Eligible Card") within the Promotion Period;
 - b) the Eligible Card applications submitted under 2(a) above must have been approved by OCBC within the Promotion Period;
 - c) the relevant individual must not be holding on to any OCBC principal credit cards at point of card approval by OCBC
 - d) the relevant individual must not have cancelled any OCBC principal credit card within the last 6 months prior to the commencement of the Promotion Period; and
 - e) Applications must be submitted through bit.ly/2sCtNnd. Other promotion channels will not be eligible for this Promotion.

S\$100 Marche Food Lovers' Card

3. If all the criteria stated in Clause 2 are met to the absolute satisfaction of OCBC, the relevant Eligible Cardmember will be entitled to receive a S\$100 Marche Food Lovers' Card no later than 2 months after the date your card has been approved pursuant to the terms and conditions set out herein. The Marche Food Lovers' Card will be mailed to your registered mailing address with the Bank.

For example, if your OCBC 365 Credit Card is approved on 31 July 2019, you will receive the Marche Food Lovers' Card by end of August 2019.

General

5. OCBC Bank's decision on all matters relating to this Promotion will be final and binding on all participants.
