

Terms and Conditions Governing the OCBC Business Debit Card Senoko Promotion (“the “Promotion”)

Promotion Period

1. This promotion is valid until 31 March 2018 or such other period (the “Promotion Period”) as may be determined by Oversea-Chinese Banking Corporation Limited (“OCBC”) in its absolute discretion.

Eligibility

2. You are eligible to take part in the Promotion (“Eligible Cardmember”) if:
 - a. You are an existing OCBC Business Debit Cardmember who signs up with Senoko Energy Supply Pte Ltd (“Senoko”) through the Senoko Energy Sign Up Form & agrees to a recurring payment to be charged to your OCBC Business Debit Card by Senoko.
 - b. You are eligible for contestability.
 - c. You are a new electricity connection sign-up with Senoko and a low tension electricity supply customer.
 - d. You agree to receive e-statements from Senoko.

Privileges

3. Eligible Cardmembers will receive a 25% discount off SP Services published electricity tariff, to their monthly charge, a security deposit waiver, as well as a one time S\$100 bill rebate per account holder based on Unique Entity Number (UEN).

Other Conditions

4. Eligible Cardmembers may be subjected to an additional pre-qualification assessment by Senoko.
5. This offer is not valid with any other discounts and privileges by Senoko or OCBC unless otherwise stated.
6. In the event that the monthly Senoko electricity bill payment ceases to be charged via recurring payment through an OCBC Business Debit Card, Senoko reserves the right to remove the privileges in the electricity retail agreement and those offered under this Promotion. In particular, the discount applied to the prevailing SP Services published electricity tariff will revert to 20% and a security deposit may be imposed. The card member will also be required to refund the S\$100 bill rebate.
7. No part of this offer is exchangeable for cash or other benefits.
8. Notwithstanding anything herein, OCBC shall not at any time be responsible or held liable for any defect or malfunction in any offer, and/or for any loss and damage suffered or incurred by or in connection with the use of the offer by Senoko.
9. OCBC shall not be responsible for the quality of any aspect of the offer. OCBC makes no representation or warranty as to the adequacy or suitability of any aspect of the offer.
10. OCBC and Senoko reserve the right to vary/amend the privileges or any terms and conditions without your consent or providing any notice to you.
