

Terms and Conditions governing the Unity Spend and Redeem Campaign 2017 (the “Promotion”)

1. NTUC/OCBC Plus! Visa Cardmembers will receive a S\$10 Unity Voucher for every S\$80 charged to their NTUC/OCBC Plus! Visa Credit/Debit Card, in a single transaction from 9th June to 6th July 2017. While stocks last.
2. NETS and cash transactions are not eligible for this Promotion.
